## **Request for LEED Credit Case Studies**

For use in our educational programs, USGBC New York is compiling case studies of individual LEED credits from project teams that have successfully navigated the New Construction certification process.

USGBC New York's educational programs are designed to familiarize attendees with the LEED standard, and with the specific knowledge needed to pass the LEED Accreditation exam. Many LEED credits are best understood when viewed through the lens of real life examples. To this end, we are requesting short case studies that provide a detailed, comprehensive sense of the credit application and project certification process.

Submissions may cover any LEED credit, with the following credits being of particular interest:

SS c2: Development Density & Community Connectivity  
WE c2: Innovative Wastewater Technologies  
EA c1: Optimize Energy Performance  
MR c 4.2: Recycled Content, 20%  
IQ c8.1: Daylight & Views, 75%

The ideal submission would include:

1. A brief project description
2. A description of the credit application, including review dialogue with USGBC
3. Calculations submitted as part of the credit application
4. Submission templates in PDF format
5. Images of the building exterior, or major interior space
6. Images of the system or technology that relates to the credit

USGBC New York provides educational programs to hundreds of people annually. Providing content for a portion of their programs is an excellent opportunity to publicize the sustainable design work of your firm.
